Robert W. Bishop was born in Kaysville, Utah and graduated from Davis High School. Rob earned his B.A. at the University of Utah and taught history and government at the high school level for 28 years. He was also a member of the part-time Utah House of Representatives for 25 years, where he had the distinction of serving as Speaker of the State House. In January of 2003, Rob took his oath of office and became a Congressman for the State of Utah. In this capacity he served as the chairman, Committee on Natural Resources, and as a member of the Committee on Armed Services. Congressman Bishop retired January 2, 2021. Awards Rob has received include: Guardian of Small Business, Thomas Jefferson Award, Spirit of Enterprise Award, Defender of Housing, and the Hero of Main Street Award. He is married to Jeralynn Hansen Bishop; they are the parents of five children.

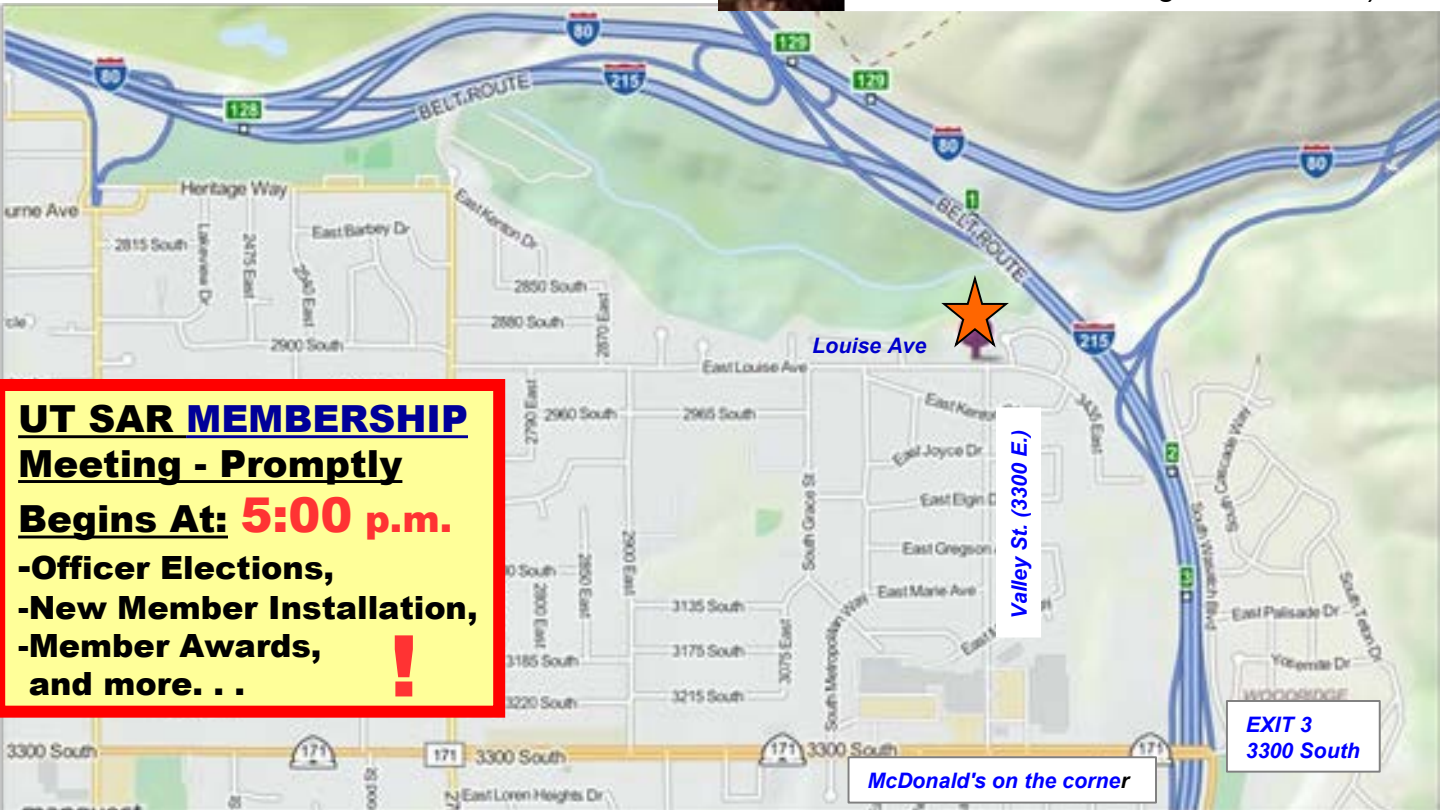

UTAH SAR BANQUET GUIDELINES

As you are probably aware, the Utah State Legislature ended the mandate for masks on April 10th.

Utah Governor Cox announced that all restrictions will be lifted as of July 1, 2021

The building manager for the Sons of the Utah Pioneers Building has indicated that for the month of May a social distancing policy will be in effect limiting the number of guests to 90.

What this means is that we can only accept reservations from the first 90 people who pay for their meal. And only 90 people can be seated in the banquet room.

Although many have already received the Covid vaccination, masks are encouraged because of the size of the group and Salt Lake County mask expectations.
