Bring your family, friends and neighbors to remember the American Revolution and meet the individual who history would declare as America's most indispensable man—George Washington.

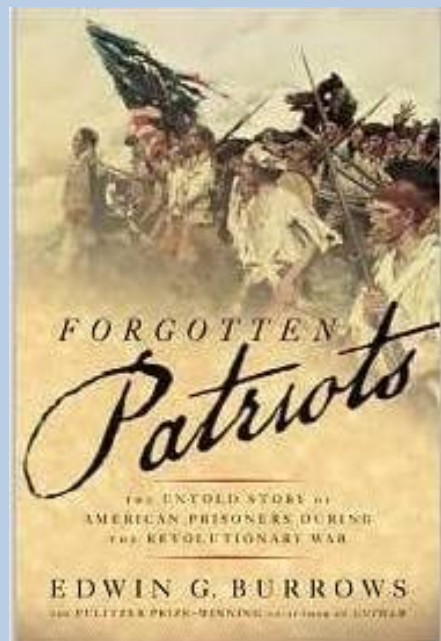

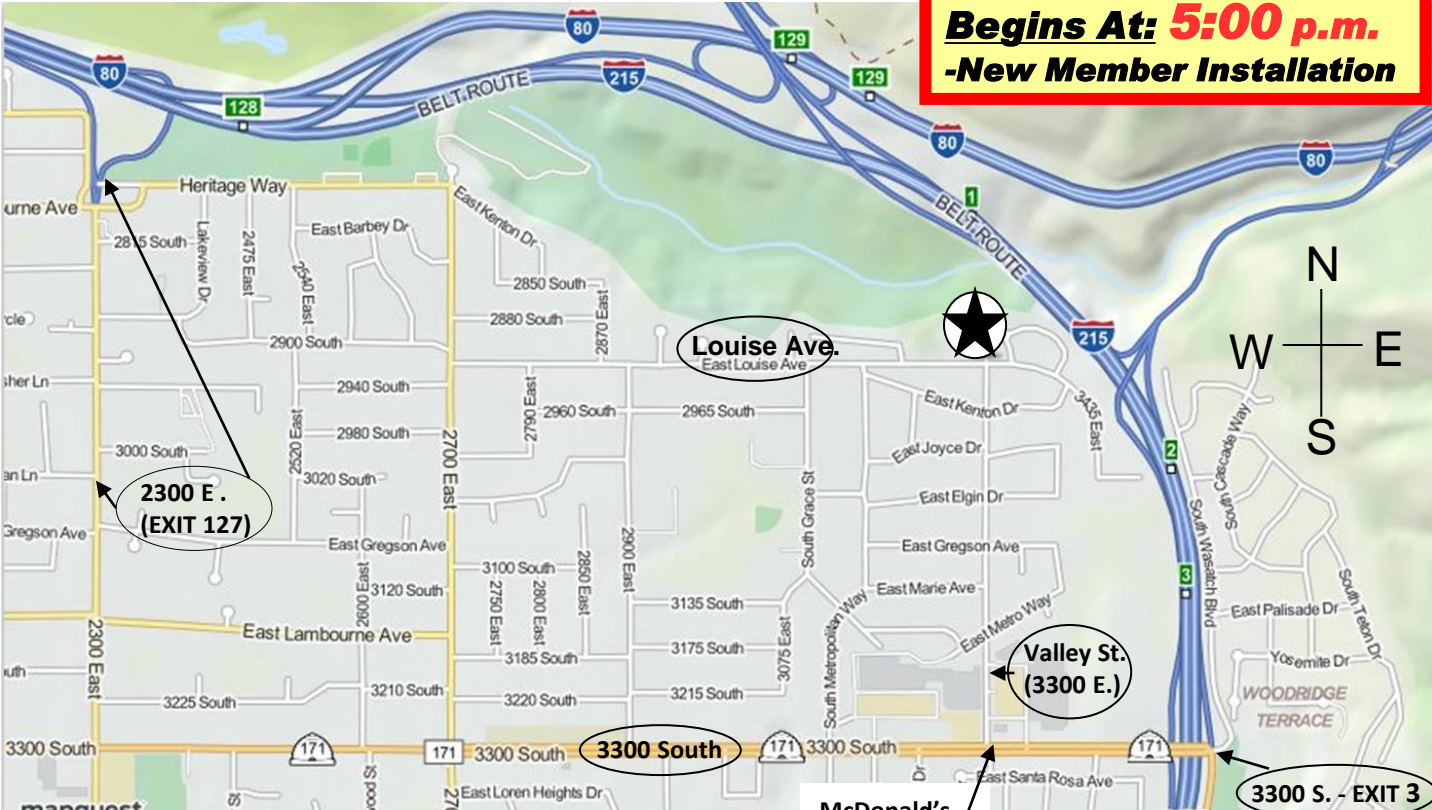

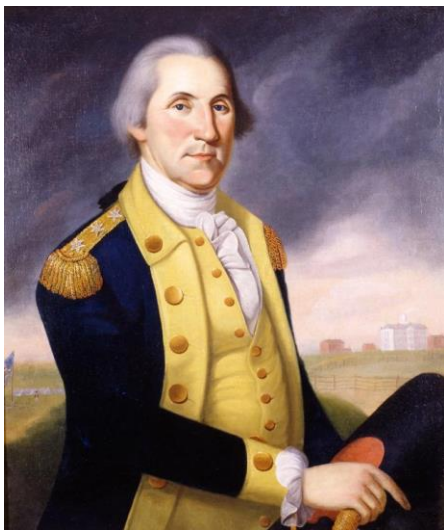
